1. (20%) A list of important customers contains 25 names. Among them, 20 persons have their accounts in good standing while 5 are delinquent. Two persons will be selected at random from this list and the status of their accounts checked. Calculate the probability that

- (a) Both accounts are delinquent.
- (b) One account is delinquent and the other is in good standing.

2. (20%) A new method of storing snap beans is believed to retain more ascorbic acid than an old method. In an experiment, snap bean were harvested under uniform conditions and frozen in 18 equal-size packages. Nine of these packages were randomly selected and stored according to the new method, and the other 9 packages were stored by the old method. Subsequently, ascorbic acid determinations (in mg/kg) were made, and the following summary statistics were calculated.

| | <u>New Method</u> | <u>Old Method</u> |
|--------------------|-------------------|-------------------|
| Mean ascorbic acid | 449 | 410 |
| Standard deviation | 19 | 45 |

Do these data substantiate the claim that more ascorbic acid is retained under the new method of storing? Test at $\alpha = 0.05$.

3. (20%) A new alloy has been devised for use in a space vehicle. Tensile strength measurements are made on 15 pieces of the alloy, and the mean and the standard deviation of these measurements are found to be 39.3 and 2.6, respectively.

- (a) Find a 90% confidence interval for the mean tensile strength of the alloy.
- (b) Is μ included in this interval?

4. (20%) A public health survey is to be designed to estimate the proportion p of a population having defective vision. How many persons should be examined if the public health commissioner wishes to be 98% certain that the error of estimation is below 0.05 when

- (a) There is no knowledge about the value of p ?
- (b) p is known to be about 0.3?

5. (20%) In an effort to improve the quality of recording tapes, the effects of four kinds of coatings A, B, C, D on the reproducing quality of sound are compared. Suppose that the measurements of sound distortion given in the table are obtained from tapes treated with the four coatings.

| <u>Coating</u> | <u>Observations</u> |
|----------------|----------------------------|
| A | 10, 15, 8, 12, 15 |
| B | 14, 18, 21, 15 |
| C | 17, 16, 14, 15, 17, 15, 18 |
| D | 12, 15, 17, 15, 16, 15 |

- (a) Construct the ANOVA table for the data given the table.
- (b) Test the null hypothesis that the means are equal. Use $\alpha = 0.05$.



TABLE 1 STANDARD NORMAL DISTRIBUTION




Area or probability


